Member's Details

Gathering Your Personal Data

- Personal data is normally gathered through the use of the STAGS Membership Application Form
- Periodically this data will be updated, for example when your email address changes or you move house

Purpose

- We gather your name, home and email address, telephone number(s), date of birth and golf handicap so as to run and administer the STAGS in an effective and co-ordinated way
- We need your personal data to be able to process membership forms and payments
- We need your personal data to communicate information with you, and other golf society members, regarding society golf days and other events we chose to organise for the benefit of the wider STAGS membership
- We also use your data to contact you in matters relating to your health, or the health of your immediate family members, so that we may enquire after the wellbeing of our members and their families
- We also use your personal data to send you information about purchasing club kit, merchandise or fundraising activities
- Use of member's personal data for any reason other than stated here is outside the STAGS GDPR Policy and responsibility of the individual member who uses it.

Data Sharing

- We share your personal data with other members of the STAGS so that they may organise society golf days and social events involving members of our society.
- Limited personal data (e.g. your name and/or photograph) may be made available on the STAGS website (www.stagsgolf.org.uk) through the posting of committee and AGM minutes, society day competition results and our list of members (past and present)
- We do not, and will not, share your data externally with any third party for any purpose other than inter-society golf competitions

Data Retention

- Data is retained on member's computer systems so that we all may communicate with other members for the purposes stated above
- Your data will be retained for as long as you remain a member of the STAGS
- When you resign your membership of the STAGS you should indicate whether you wish us to retain your information or delete it (the right to be forgotten)
- If advised we will erase your data from our central membership records held by the STAGS Membership Secretary within one month of receipt of your request
- The Membership Secretary will also advise members of your resignation and, if you request it, ask them to erase any personal data relating to you they hold.

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
